## Membership Renewal

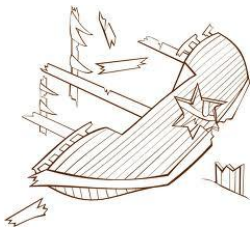
Please remember the membership year starts on the 1st March.
